DB Bistro Moderne

New York-based Daniel Boulud has spent many weeks here lately, training staff, testing menu items, and—with local partners David and Manjy Sidoo—overseeing the completion of DB Bistro Moderne and the adjoining Lumière. The rooms opened for dinner last week; this week the 65-seat bistro added lunch (and weekend brunch).

Food lovers, rejoice: DB Bistro offers freshly conceived, deeply flavorful dishes (the orechiette with venison and chestnut was superb, the lobster salad replete with perfectly cooked meat) amid the same polished buzz (“Isn’t that Willie Mitchell with David Hawksworth?”) that animates Boulud’s Manhattan rooms. His signature DB Burger—a delectable, baseball-sized offering of ground sirloin, boned short rib, foie gras, and black truffle—is a test of manhood; it was the choice of the noon-hour brokerage types and jocks on Tuesday. The place was humming with ladies who lunch and foodies who appreciate fastidious cuisine delivered in a beautifully imagined room.
